Scheduled to take place from April 12-14, 2024, at Camp Wilderness (3065 Hwy 17 S, Fort Meade, FL 33841), this Pow Wow is a Royal Rangers gathering welcoming men, boys, fathers, sons, and teen guys from across the district.

This year's Pow Wow theme is "Connected," ( Bible verse for this year's camp will be John 15:4-7 ERV ) with a special focus on video arcade games. We invite you to join us in celebrating this vibrant event.

Throughout the day, boys will engage in a variety of enjoyable activities, including archery, BB gun competitions, and more. However, the primary emphasis of the Pow Wow lies in the spiritual aspects, with nightly services and special devotions. We anticipate witnessing the Holy Spirit moving in the hearts of our boys.

The registration fee covers a hat, t-shirt, patch, and an entire weekend of fun. Children need to have a completed application signed by their parents, and adult applications must be signed by the Senior Pastor.

If your church doesn't have Royal Rangers, your group of boys is more than welcome to participate. Age groups are as follows:

Rangers Kids: Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd Grades  
Discovery Rangers: 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grades  
Adventure Rangers: 6th, 7th, and 8th Grades  
Expedition Rangers: 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Grades

We invite you to join the staff on April 7, 2024, for a day of fasting and prayer, seeking God's anointing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. We believe that you and your boys will be truly blessed by this experience.

# POW WOW INFORMATION

These guidelines have been established to safeguard the health and well-being of all participants at the Pow Wow and to ensure that everyone has a delightful experience. Your cooperation in reading and adhering to these rules is greatly appreciated. In case of emergencies, please contact us at 813-927-4061 or 813-927-4062.

Upon your arrival, please follow these instructions:

## 1. REGISTRATION FEES:

- Early registration fees for Chartered Outposts are \$85.00 per person, and \$96.00 per person for Non-Chartered Outposts. A partial registration of \$45.00 per person is required by March 1, 2024, with the remaining balance due at the event to secure your HAT, PATCH, and T-SHIRT. After March 1, 2024, the fee increases to \$100.00 per person, and hats, T-shirts & patches are not guaranteed.
- Senior Pastors attend for free.
- Female Ranger Kids Commanders can stay overnight in the lodge for an extra \$25.00 (limited to 20 beds). Please add them to your pre-registration to reserve their bed.
- Visitors attending Saturday only must register and pay \$10 per person.

## 2. ITEMS TO BE COMPLETED AT REGISTRATION:

- All participants must have an individual application with the appropriate signatures. Incomplete applications, lacking signatures, will result in the person being asked to leave.
- Registration is open on Friday from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm. All participants must register and wear the issued wristband.

## 3. RULES FOR THE WOMEN

- Only Ranger Kids Commanders can stay overnight if their church brings Ranger Kids to Pow Wow. Females under 18 are not allowed. The ratio for FEMALE RK Commanders is 5 boys to one commander.
- Designated area for women in the lodge (limited to 20 beds). They must keep the room and restrooms clean, and adhere to curfew and rules, or they will be asked to leave.

## 4. PLEASE FOLLOW THE POW WOW SCHEDULE.

- Kindly comply with the Pow Wow schedule as we strive to maintain punctuality. During assemblies, no one must remain in their campsite.
- Boys are not obligated to wear RR uniforms for the night Council Services. However, we recommend they wear long pants for these evening gatherings.

## 5. COMMANDERS – IT IS IMPERATIVE TO KEEP TRACK OF YOUR OUTPOST MEMBERS'

LOCATIONS AT ALL TIMES. Advise your members against crossing designated boundaries, as points will be deducted for those found outside RR areas. Pay attention to tent stakes and ropes and ensure that no Royal Rangers venture beyond the designated areas during the Pow Wow. "LIGHTS OUT AND QUIET" BEGINS AT MIDNIGHT. There should be no activities such as running, loud conversations, wood chopping, generator operation, or any other disruptive noises after this time. Security personnel will strictly enforce these guidelines. Maintain a cohesive group dynamic within your outpost, with the commander overseeing and taking responsibility for the actions of their boys. Commanders, it is crucial to always stay informed about the whereabouts and activities of your outpost members!

## 6. Ground fires are strictly prohibited at Camp Wilderness. Advise your boys against cutting down any live trees or bushes; only deadwood is permitted for use as firewood. Campfires are allowed, but they must be contained within a metal receptacle elevated above the ground. The use of propane and/or gas stoves is permitted. Ensure that you have adequate fire extinguishing items on hand in case of emergencies. Dispose of all trash by placing it in plastic bags and depositing them in the designated "Dumpster." A trash trailer or pickup service will be available for this purpose.

## 7. COOKING – Commanders bear the responsibility of providing meals for the entire outpost, which includes Rangers Kids, Helpers, and Visitors. Females are not permitted at the campsite during breakfast. For their morning meals, they should bring and prepare their own breakfast in the Lodge.

**8. VISITATION GUIDELINES:** Visitors are welcome on Saturdays during the day but must check in at the registration area and pay a \$10 fee for a one-day pass. Females under the age of 18 are not permitted. Visiting hours are from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm on Friday and from 9:00 am to 10:00 pm on Saturday. Women are restricted from entering the campsite area before 7:30 am. All visitors are required to register at the designated booth and obtain a wristband. Failure to wear the wristband may lead to a request to leave the premises. We kindly request that visitors leave promptly after visiting hours and respect the privacy rights of the boys and men in their camps..

**9. SHOWER HOUSE** is for all Men and boys only. Commanders must accompany the rangers to the shower houses. The commander must first check the condition of the shower house each time they arrive for cleanliness and to see if there are available showers for the boys. When the boys are done, the Commander will check to confirm that the boys have not left any clothes behind or anything else!!! Men are not allowed to take a shower while the boys are taking a shower and vice versa. Please make sure your boys and commanders keep the showers clean.

**10. ROAD SPEED LIMIT NOTICE: THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON ALL CAMP ROADS IS 5 MPH.** This regulation is implemented for the safety of your boys. Kindly adhere to this speed limit upon exiting the highway and throughout the camp premises. It is strictly prohibited to allow your boys to ride in the back of a pick-up truck or on your trailer while within the camp area. Your cooperation in maintaining a safe speed and following these guidelines is greatly appreciated.

**11. WATER FACILITIES NOTICE:** Water faucets are situated on the side of the restrooms and various locations across the campsite. However, it is essential to bring your water containers for storage and transportation.

**12. PORTABLE TOILET NOTICE:** Each general camp area will be equipped with portable toilets for your convenience. In situations where your boys may have difficulty reaching the regular restrooms, please encourage them to utilize these portable facilities rather than venturing into the woods.

**13. DRESS CODE:**

- Morning Assemblies: Outpost uniforms or comfortable clothing.
- Daytime Games & Activities: Comfortable clothing (all participants must wear a shirt).
- Evening Services: Comfortable clothing (all attendees must wear a shirt).

**14. PARKING NOTICE: NO VEHICLES ALLOWED IN THE CAMPING AREAS.** Each outpost is required to utilize the designated parking areas provided. Security Oversight:

- Security personnel will collaborate with campsites to enforce parking regulations. Failure to comply may lead to a deduction of overall points and periodic visits from security and district staff as needed.
- Exception: Vehicles will be permitted to re-enter the camp during Sunday morning's breakfast for loading purposes.

**15. SECURITY NOTICE:**

- Continuous Coverage: Security personnel will be on duty around the clock to ensure your safety and convenience.
- Emergency Assistance: In the event of an emergency or any urgent requirements, please do not hesitate to call for security assistance.
- Mode of Transportation: Security will primarily be using golf carts for their patrols.
- Respectful Cooperation: Kindly instruct your boys to heed the requests and instructions of the security personnel, fostering a cooperative and secure environment.

**16. MEDICAL SUPPORT INFORMATION:**

- Paramedic Availability: A medical technician (paramedic) will always be on standby for assistance.
- First Aid Station: The First Aid Station is situated at the Lodge for medical assistance. In cases where immediate attention is required and transporting the individual to the first aid building is not feasible, please inform security, and they will contact the first aid station.
- Commander Responsibility: Commanders are ultimately responsible for notifying a boy's parents if hospitalization is necessary. This responsibility does not fall on the First Aid Officers.
- Medication Permissions: Ensure that parental permission slips are signed for any medication. Commanders should keep the original medical release forms for their boys and provide a copy to the First Aid Officer.

**17. SMOKING POLICY:** Smoking is strictly prohibited within the camp premises.

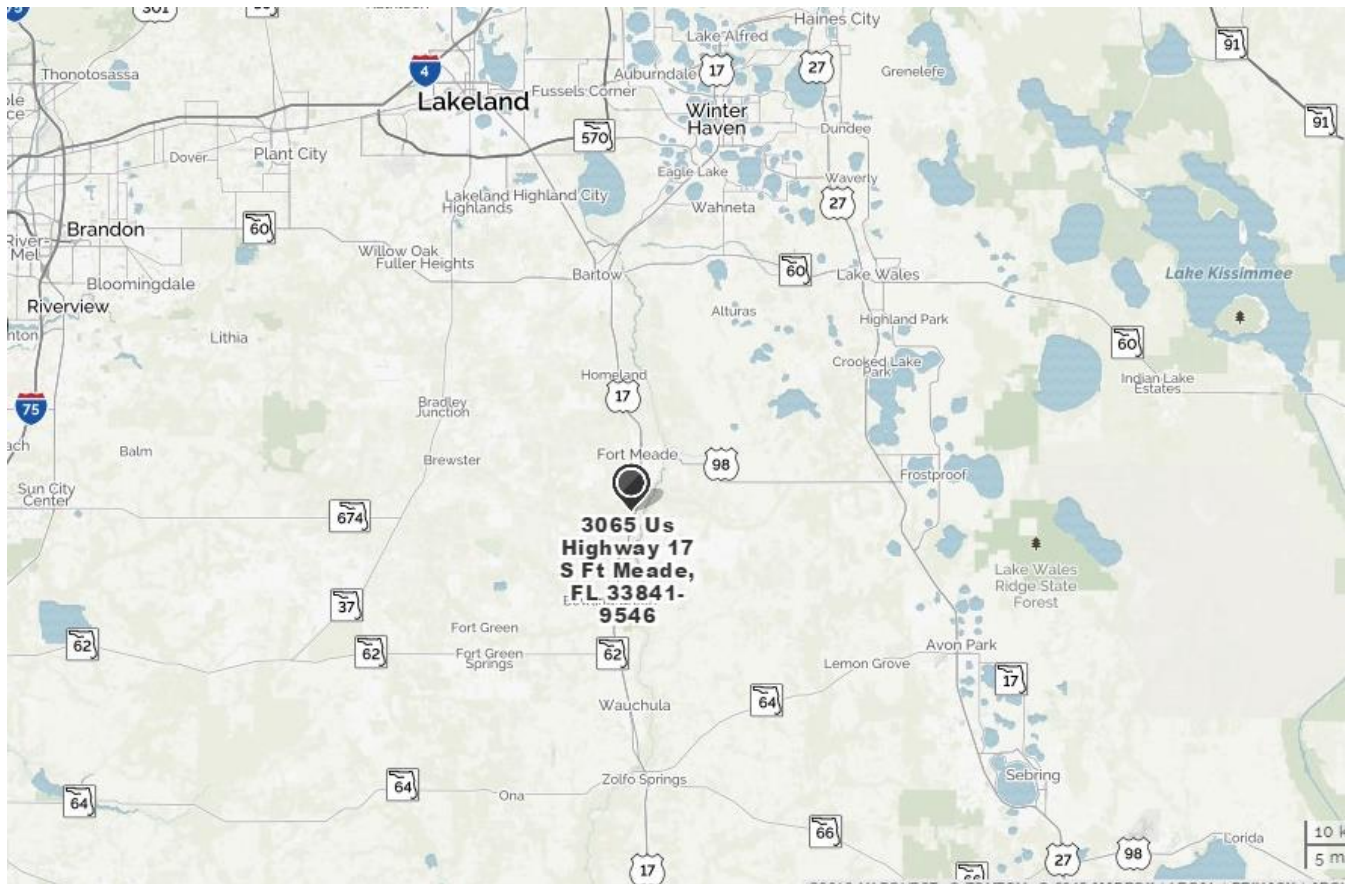
